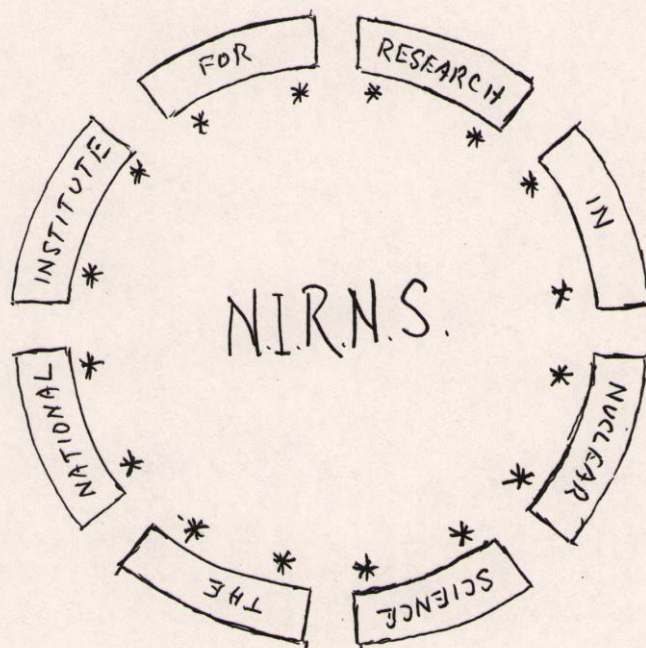
COMMON SEAL

Note by the Secretary

The Institute will shortly require a common seal. Members will recall that some designs were put forward two years ago after a competition at Harwell, but none was thought suitable. Now that some property conveyances are expected very soon, it is necessary to adopt a seal. It need not be permanent, as the Institute in their Royal Charter are given power to "break, alter and make anew" their seal "at their will and pleasure".

I therefore now propose a simple design for use for the time being.
